The awards recognize exemplary developments that meet workforce housing needs in high-cost communities. Award winners will be honored at a ceremony during the 2009 ULI Fall Meeting in San Francisco, California.

Developments will be selected based on the following criteria:

- ▶ Affordability
- ▶ Proximity to centers of employment and transportation hubs
- ▶ Quality of the design and site planning
- ▶ Involvement of public and private partnerships
- ▶ Use of regulatory reform to reduce costs
- ▶ Energy efficiency
- ▶ Sustainable green construction and land development
- ▶ Innovative building technologies and systems
- ▶ The value of the project as a worthy model for emulation
